

Donna Spinato Scholarship Application Guidelines

Annually, the Texas Association of College and University Police Administrators (TACUPA) provides educational scholarship opportunities to higher education police department and security department employees.

Scholarship is in the amount of \$500.

Eligibility criteria and application guidelines include:

- All applicants must be from an agency that has at least one employee who is a member of TACUPA.
- Applicants must be full-time non-sworn employees of a higher education police or security department as defined by Article 2.12 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedures.
- Chief Administrative Officers are not eligible for this scholarship.
- Applicants must be enrolled at an accredited college or university and making progress towards a Bachelor's or Master's Degree.
- Applicants must possess a minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average.
- Applicants must complete a signed application that is endorsed by the Chief Administrative Officer and submit the application, a resume, college transcript and a one-page essay outlining career aspirations (not to exceed 500 words).
